**WASHING HANDS THOROUGHLY WITH SOAP AND WATER WILL
REDUCE THE CHANCE OF INFECTION**

WASH HANDS BEFORE EATING OR DRINKING

**SUPERVISE CHILDREN CLOSELY TO ENSURE THAT THEY
WASH THEIR HANDS PROPERLY AFTER CONTACTS WITH
ANIMALS**

DO NOT PUT FINGERS IN MOUTHS WHILE PETTING ANIMALS

**DO NOT EAT OR DRINK WHILE TOUCHING ANIMALS OR
WALKING AROUND THE ANIMAL AREA**

NO PUSH-CHAIRS IN THE CATTLE LINES AT ANY TIME

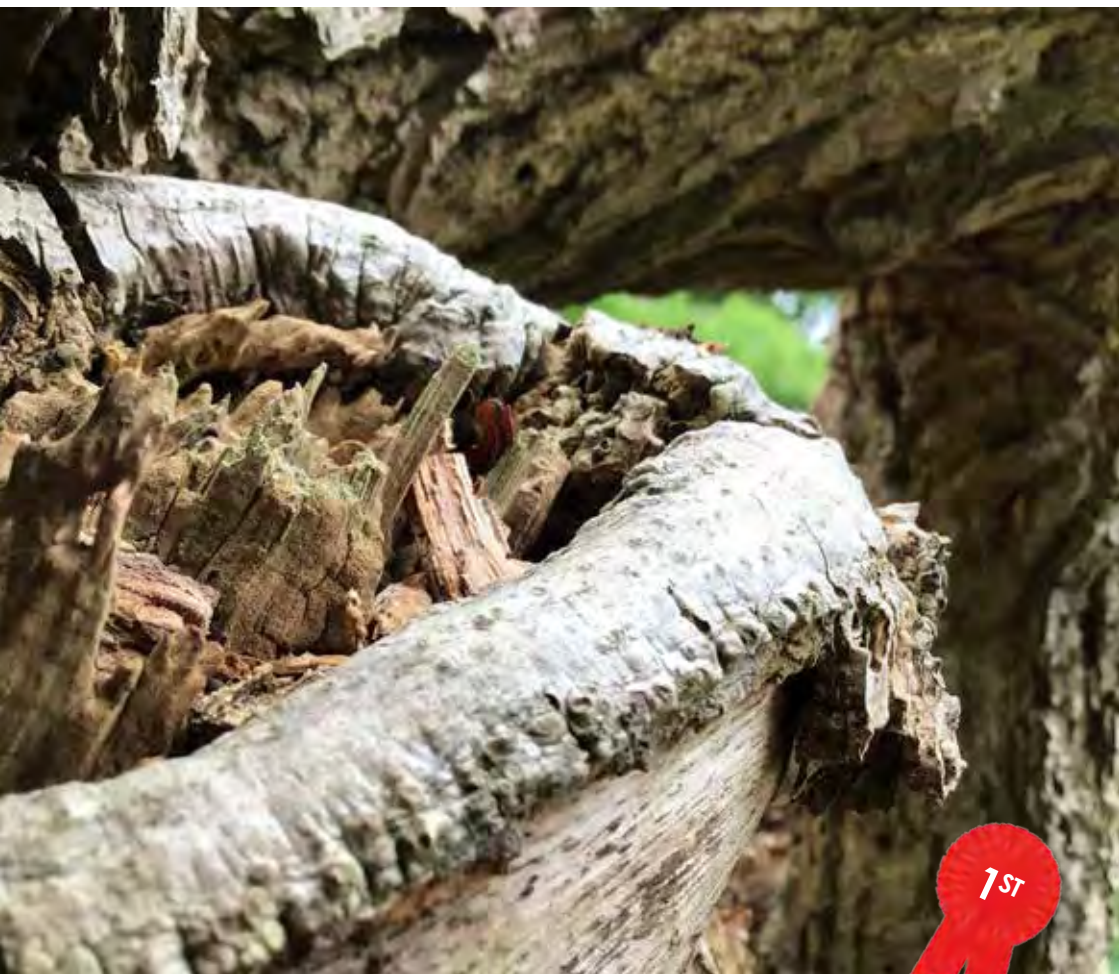

Equine Welfare

Welfare is of paramount importance and all riders should be of an appropriate size and weight for the horse/pony being ridden, anywhere on the showground. The Society reserves the right to take further action against any competitor or exhibitor whose animal is being ridden by anyone whose size or weight compromises the welfare of the horse/pony being ridden; this would be based on the recommendations of the on-site veterinary team, who will use the 20% ratio as a guideline (this means the combined weight of rider plus their saddle should be less than 20% of the animal's weight). This would be based on a relatively fit, healthy animal, as an overweight animal is also a welfare concern.

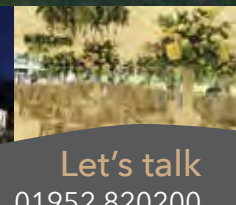
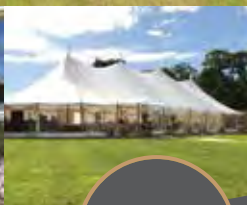

- (b) Separate transport must be used for MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep, and there will be separate unloading points clearly marked.
- (c) In open penning, 2m separation will be allowed between penning of MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep.
- (d) There will be separate watering facilities for MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep.
- (e) MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep may be allowed in the same ring, but should be led by a halter or collar and there should be a 2m space between different categories. It is accepted that judges will need to pass between and handle the sheep, but any examinations such as mouthing, should be carried out by the handler for the judge's inspection.
- (f) MV accredited stock which come into contact with non-MV accredited stock, in any circumstances, will immediately lose their status. If they are to return to Scheme premises they must be placed immediately in isolation and pass 2 blood tests - the first straight away and the second between 6-12 months later. If both tests are clear they may rejoin their MV accredited flock. Please contact SAC Sheep & Goat Health Schemes immediately for advice, in the event of contact between MV accredited and non-MV accredited stock taking place.

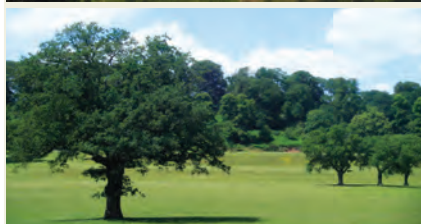
