Visiting the animal sections is an enjoyable and educational experience for many people, particularly children. However, such visits can never be free from all risks. Farm animals, even those that look clean and healthy, carry infections that can be harmful to people including E.coli 0157.

Some simple rules to help keep you and your children safe from infections:

**WASHING HANDS THOROUGHLY WITH SOAP AND WATER WILL  
REDUCE THE CHANCE OF INFECTION**

**WASH HANDS BEFORE EATING OR DRINKING**

**SUPERVISE CHILDREN CLOSELY TO ENSURE THAT THEY  
WASH THEIR HANDS PROPERLY AFTER CONTACTS WITH  
ANIMALS**

**DO NOT PUT FINGERS IN MOUTHS WHILE PETTING ANIMALS**

**DO NOT EAT OR DRINK WHILE TOUCHING ANIMALS OR  
WALKING AROUND THE ANIMAL AREA**

**NO PUSH-CHAIRS IN THE CATTLE LINES AT ANY TIME**

Hand washing facilities are provided in each of the toilet blocks.

## **Equine Welfare**

Welfare is of paramount importance and all riders should be of an appropriate size and weight for the horse/pony being ridden, anywhere on the showground. The Society reserves the right to take further action against any competitor or exhibitor whose animal is being ridden by anyone whose size or weight compromises the welfare of the horse/pony being ridden; this would be based on the recommendations of the on-site veterinary team, who will use the 20% ratio as a guideline (this means the combined weight of rider plus their saddle should be less than 20% of the animal's weight). This would be based on a relatively fit, healthy animal, as an overweight animal is also a welfare concern.

## BULLS & BULL HANDLING

- a) All Bulls above one year old must have rings or "bulldogs" on their noses, and should be rung not less than 2 months before intended use of the ring as a handling aid.
- b) Bulls must be handled and led according to the Guidance Notes AIS 35 (Health and Safety Executive).
- c) All Bulls must be double tied using neck ties.
- d) During the period the Show is open to the public, mature Bulls should not be left unattended.
- e) **All Senior Bulls must have 2 able handlers in attendance in the Show Ring and in the Grand Parade.**

## CATTLE TRACING SYSTEM - REPORTING MOVEMENTS TO AND FROM SHOWGROUNDS in 2025 (Show Holding Number 35/129/8002)

NADAS will record an ON / OFF movement with BCMS on the day of the show. It is the responsibility of exhibitors to record their cattle movements off their holding and back on again. On arrival at the show ground exhibitors are requested to take their cattle passports as soon as possible to the livestock office where they will be processed and immediately returned along with their exhibitor numbers. Exhibitor numbers will only be available from the livestock office on inspection of passports.

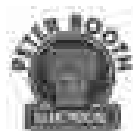

## MAEDI VISNA ACCREDITED FLOCK SCHEME

- (a) **Sheep from MV accredited flocks must be accompanied by a fully completed SAC Health Status report, which must be valid on show date. This will be collected on arrival and sent to SAC.**
- (b) Separate transport must be used for MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep, and there will be separate unloading points clearly marked.
- (c) In open penning, 2m separation will be allowed between penning of MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep.
- (d) There will be separate watering facilities for MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep.
- (e) MV accredited and non-MV accredited sheep may be allowed in the same ring, but should be led by a halter or collar and there should be a 2m space between different categories. It is accepted that judges will need to pass between and handle the sheep, but any examinations such as mouthing, should be carried out by the handler for the judge's inspection.
- (f) MV accredited stock which come into contact with non-MV accredited stock, in any circumstances, will immediately lose their status. If they are to return to Scheme premises they must be placed immediately in isolation and pass 2 blood tests - the first straight away and the second between 6-12 months later. If both tests are clear they may rejoin their MV accredited flock. Please contact SAC Sheep & Goat Health Schemes immediately for advice, in the event of contact between MV accredited and non-MV accredited stock taking place.

**All sheep exhibitors will have their completed AML 2. forms (Both in & out) collected on arrival at the Livestock gate.**

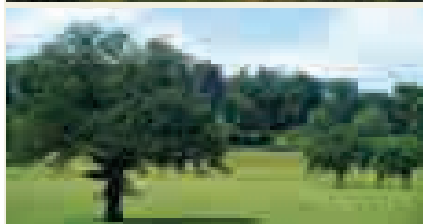
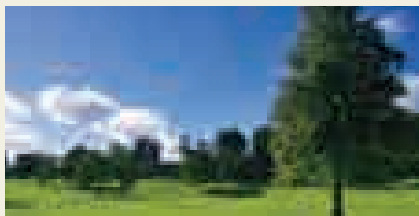
