WALKING AROUND THE ANIMAL AREA**

NO PUSH-CHAIRS IN THE CATTLE LINES AT ANY TIME

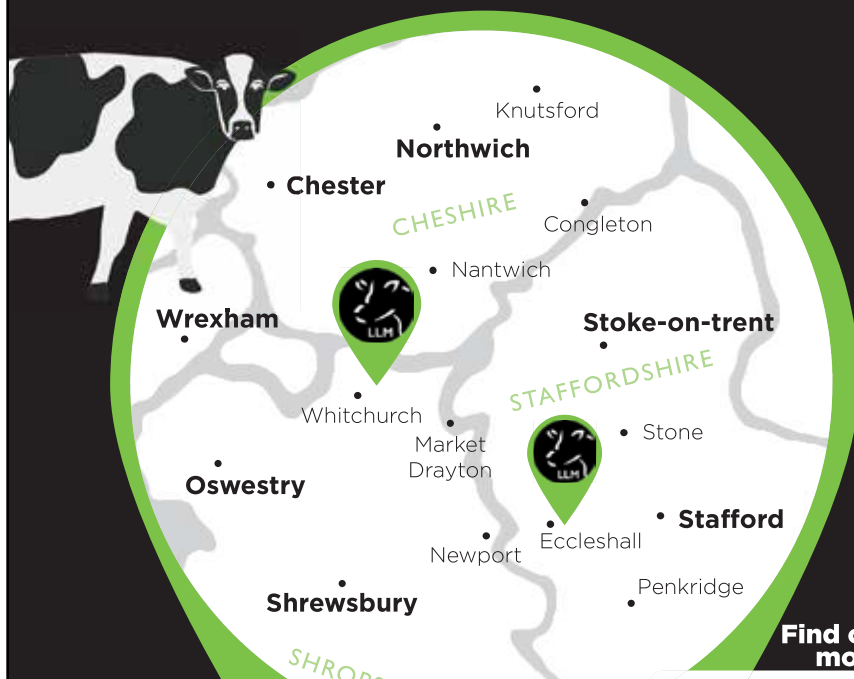

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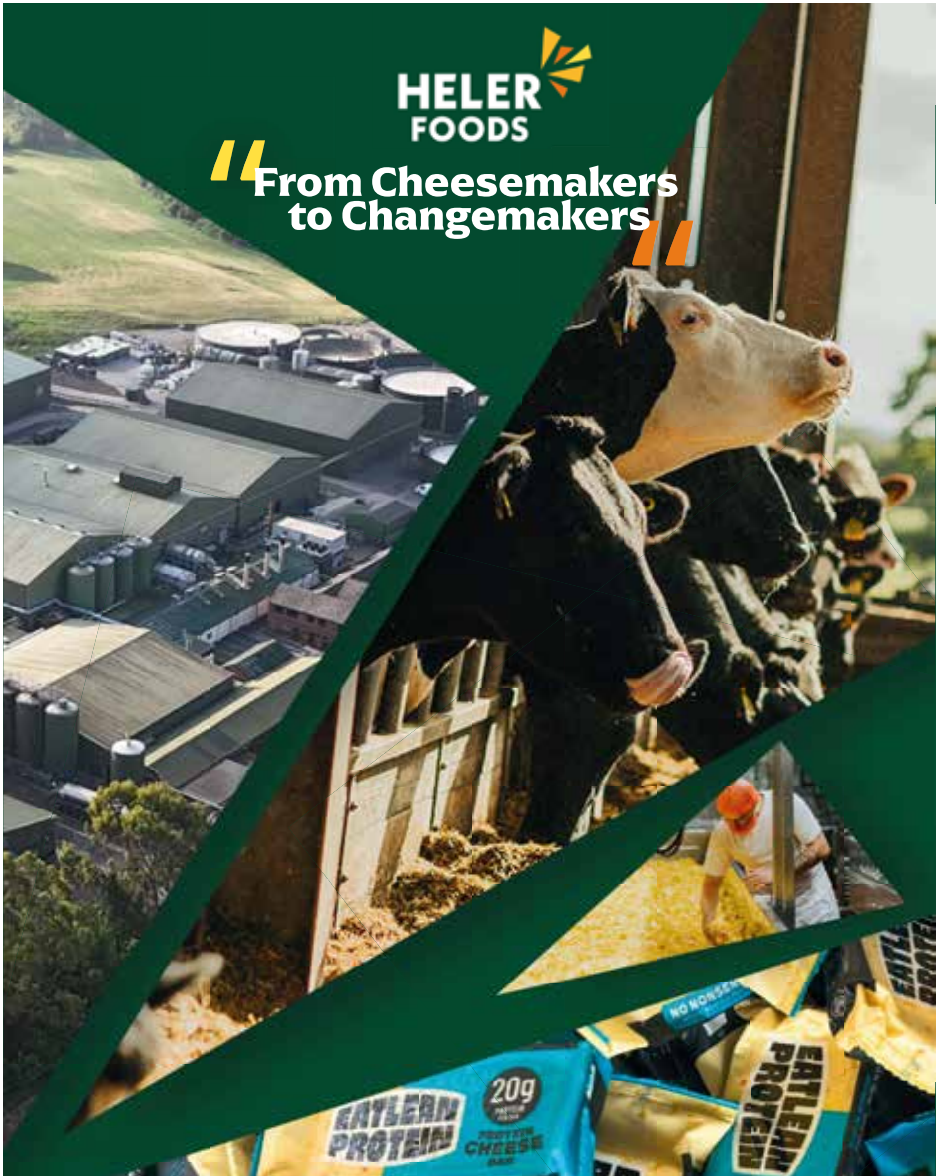
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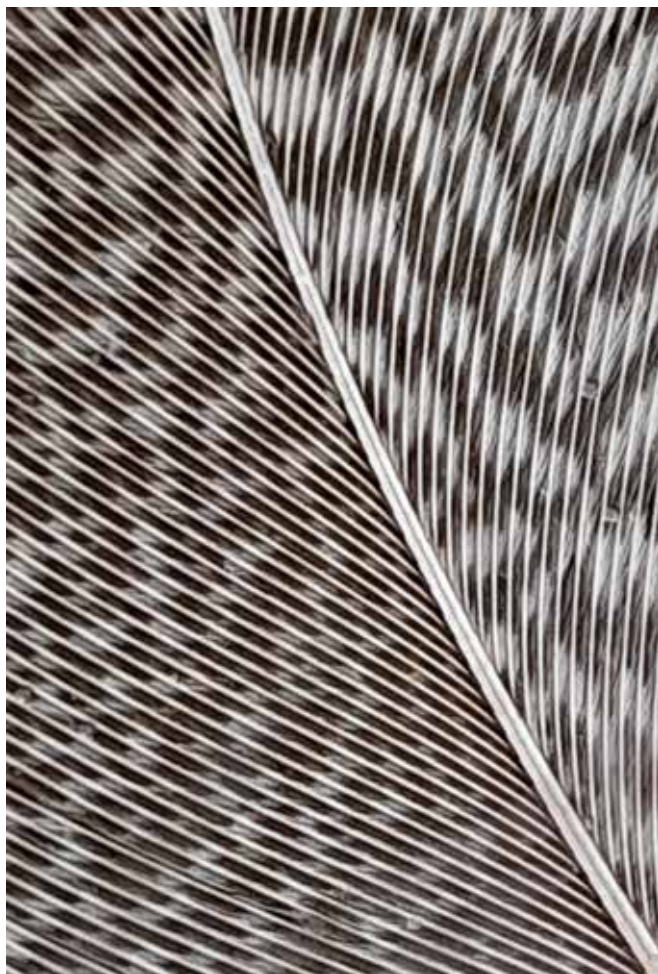

SAFETY NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS AND ACCOMPANYING PERSONS

The Organisers and Show Committee will take any necessary precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of persons on the Showground. It is a condition of entry to the Showground that all persons will act on any instruction given to them by the Show Committee, in so far, that it can affect the Health and Safety of others.

All persons attending have a responsibility under Section 7 of the Health and Safety Act that they have due regard to others.

EXHIBITORS MUST ONLY LEAD OR RIDE THEIR HORSE IN ANY AREA, OR ON ANY ROAD, RING OR WALKWAY WHICH IS MARKED:-

“STOCK AND HANDLERS ONLY”

Anyone on a horse at an affiliated show must wear a hard hat. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet current safety standards **MUST** be worn by riders at all times when mounted.

Grooms & Handlers entering show rings must be suitably attired and wearing a hat.

HORSES TETHERED TO VEHICLES MUST HAVE A RESPONSIBLE PERSON (Over 16 years) IN ATTENDANCE AT ALL TIMES!

Equine Welfare

Welfare is of paramount importance and all riders should be of an appropriate size and weight for the horse/pony being ridden, anywhere on the showground. The Society reserves the right to take further action against any competitor or exhibitor whose animal is being ridden by anyone whose size or weight compromises the welfare of the horse/pony being ridden; this would be based on the recommendations of the on-site veterinary team, who will use the 20% ratio as a guideline (this means the combined weight of rider plus their saddle should be less than 20% of the animal's weight). This would be based on a relatively fit, healthy animal, as an overweight animal is also a welfare concern.

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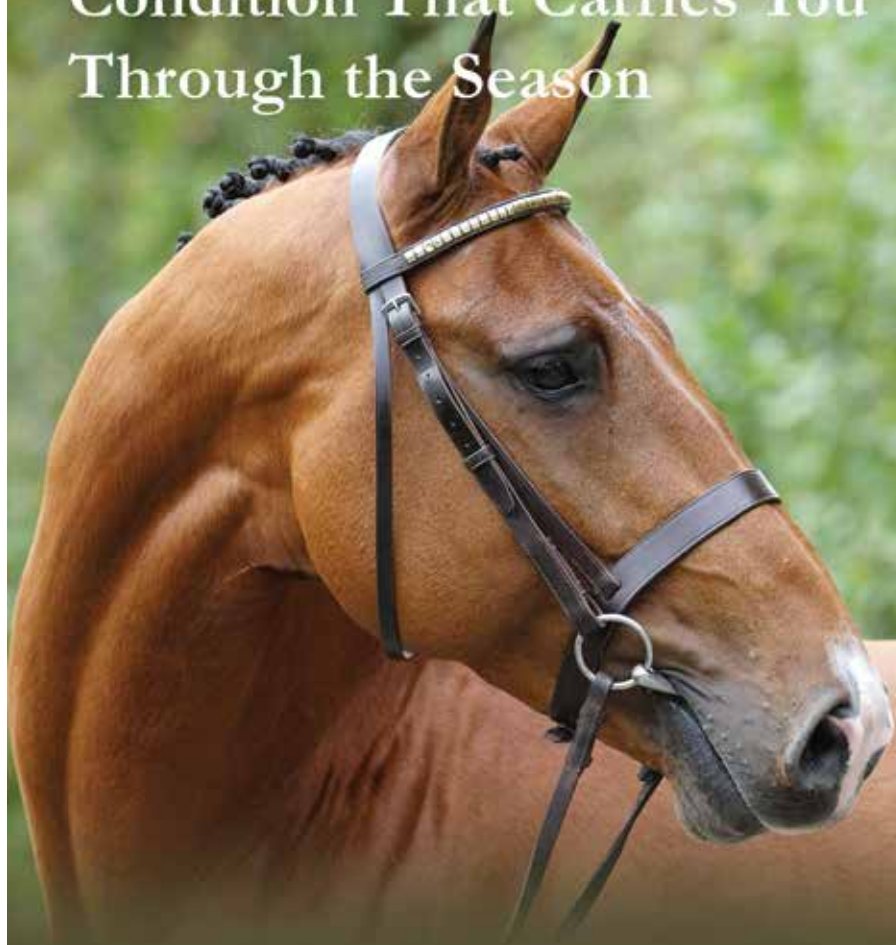

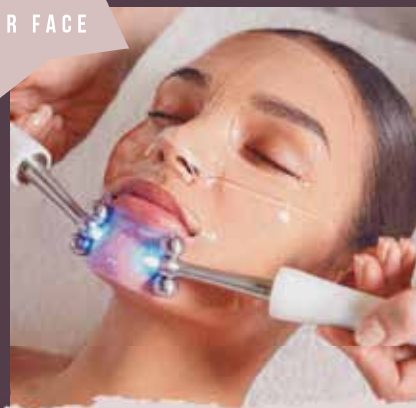

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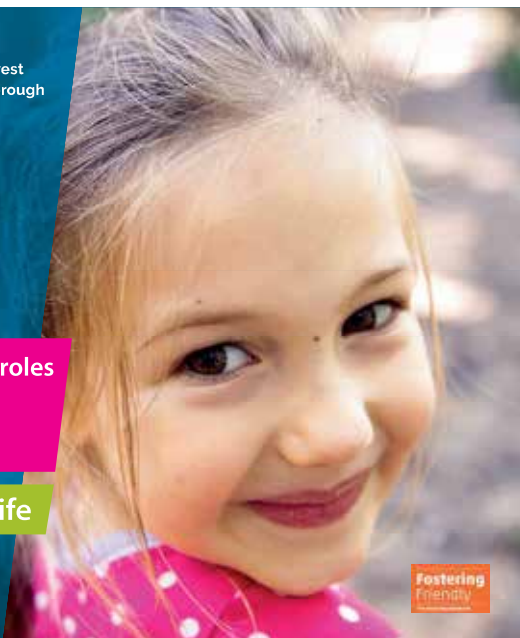

- (a) **Sheep from MV accredited flocks must be accompanied by a fully completed SAC Health Status report, which must be valid on show date. This will be collected on arrival and sent to SAC.**
- (b) Separate transport must be used for MV accredited and non MV accredited sheep, and there will be separate unloading points clearly marked.
- (c) In open penning, 2m separation will be allowed between penning of MV accredited and non MV accredited sheep.
- (d) There will be separate watering facilities for MV accredited and non MV accredited sheep.
- (e) MV accredited and non MV accredited sheep may be allowed in the same ring, but should be led by a halter or collar and there should be a 2m space between different categories. It is accepted that judges will need to pass between and handle the sheep, but any examinations such as mouthing, should be carried out by the handler for the judge's inspection.
- (f) MV accredited stock which come into contact with non MV accredited stock, in any circumstances, will immediately lose their status. If they are to return to Scheme premises they must be placed immediately in isolation and pass 2 blood tests - the first straight away and the second between 6-12 months later. If both tests are clear they may rejoin their MV accredited flock. Please contact SAC Sheep & Goat Health Schemes immediately for advice, in the event of contact between MV accredited and non MV accredited stock taking place.

All sheep exhibitors will have their completed AML 2. forms (Both in & out) collected on arrival at the Livestock gate.
